Archbishop Christophe Pierre, Apostolic Nuncio to the United States has informed me that Pope Francis has named *Anna and Gerald Davis* to the pontifical Order of St. Gregory the Great as Dame and Knight of St. Gregory. For laypersons other than Catholic royalty, heads of government or state, and senior diplomats or similar international public figures, the knightly Order of St. Gregory the Great is the single highest honor the Holy Father can bestow on an individual.

Pope Francis confers this recognition in gratitude for sustained and exceptional service to the Church and her people.

Pontifical honors will be awarded during a Vespers Service at 4:00 pm on Sunday, January 21<sup>st</sup>, at Philadelphia's Cathedral Basilica of SS. Peter and Paul. (excerpt from letter to Archbishop Charles Chaput)
