HOW TO STAY SAFE IN THE WORLD TODAY

1. Avoid riding in automobiles because they are responsible for 20% of all fatal accidents.
2. Do not stay home because 17% of all accidents occur at home.
3. Avoid walking on streets or sidewalks because 14% of all accidents occur to pedestrians.
4. Avoid traveling by rail or water because 16% of all accidents involve these forms of transportation.
5. Of all the remaining 33%, 32% of all deaths occur in hospitals. Above all else avoid hospitals.

You will be pleased to learn that only .001% of all deaths occur during worship services in Church, and these are usually related to previous physical disorders. Therefore, logic tells us that the safest place for you to be, any given point in time, is at Church!

Bible Study is safe too. The percentage of deaths during Bible study is even less.
