## STEWARDSHIP CORNER

### **ARE YOU 70 ½ OR OLDER AND WANT TO MAKE A REAL IMPACT HERE AT ST. ISAAC JOGUES?**

The president recently made permanent a law which allows you to move money from your IRA directly to a qualified non-profit organization such as St. Isaac Jogues Parish, without having to pay any income taxes on the money moved. Your gift will qualify under the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2016 if:

- You are age 70 ½ or older at the time of the gift
- You transfer an amount not more than \$100,000 per person (\$200,000 per couple) in a given tax year directly from your IRA. (This opportunity applies only to IRAs and not to other types of retirement plans.)
- No goods or services are received in the exchange


