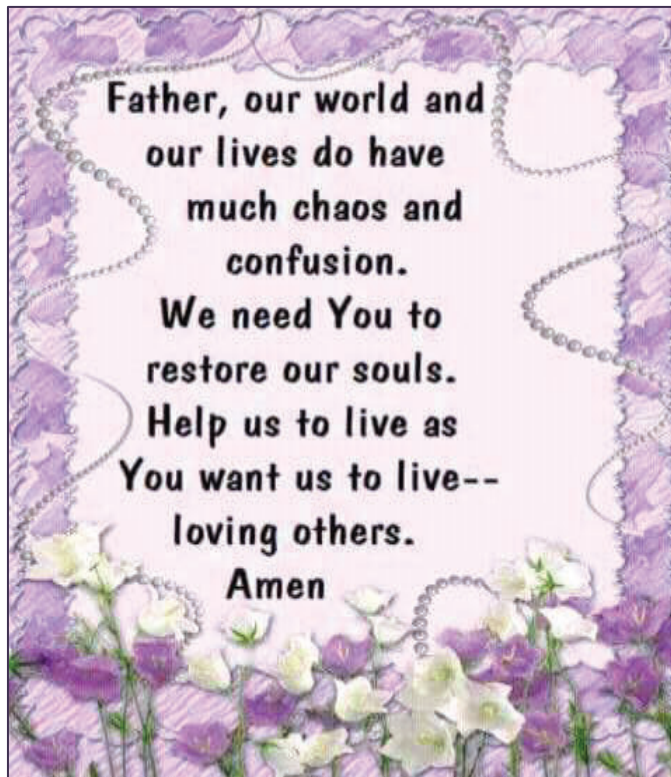
St. Malachy has requested no dinners they will be distributed locally.
