Arrangements for the Sacrament of Baptism are to be made at the Rectory Office after the parents and Godparents have attended the Pre-Jordan program.

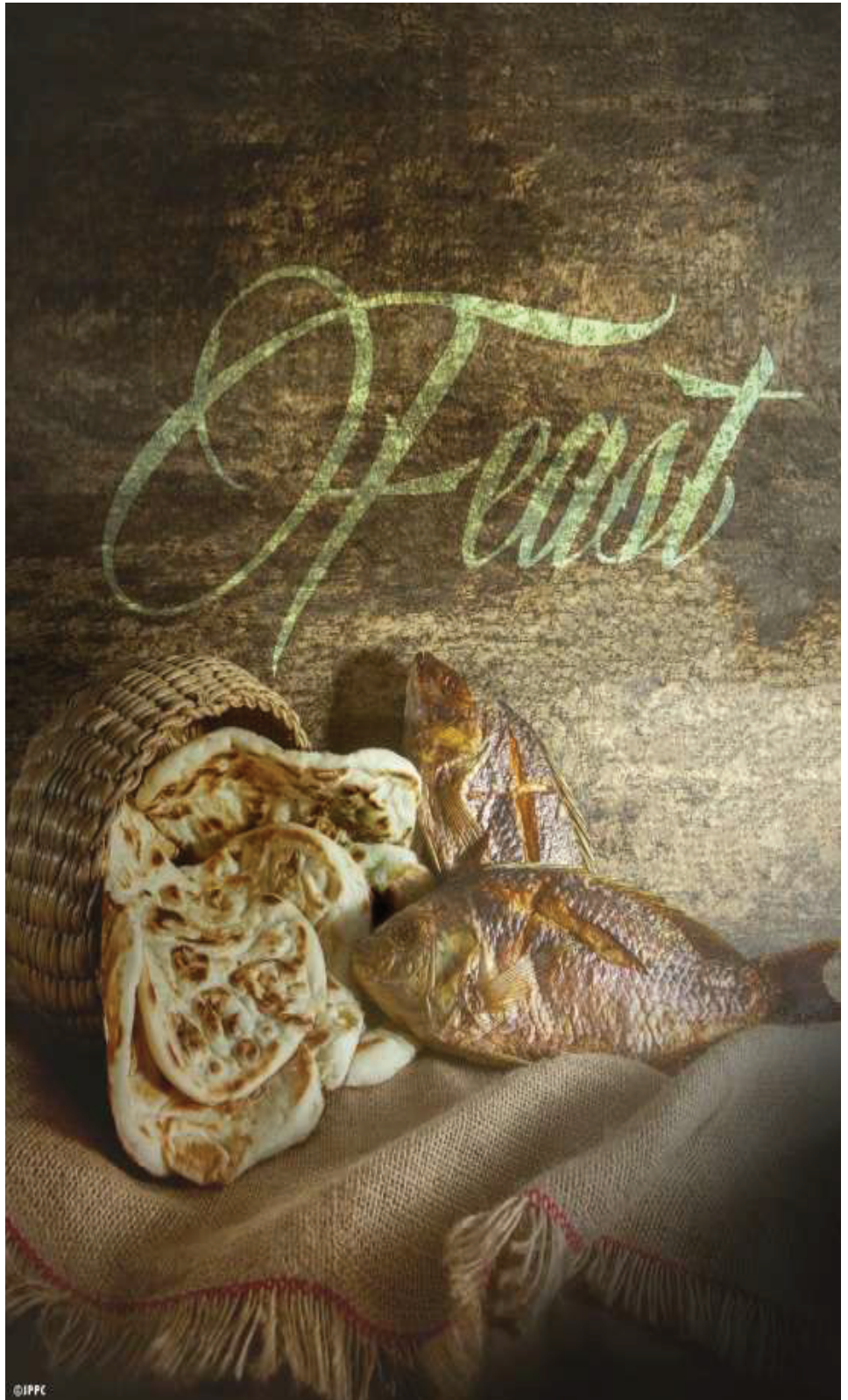
*Sacrament of Marriage:*

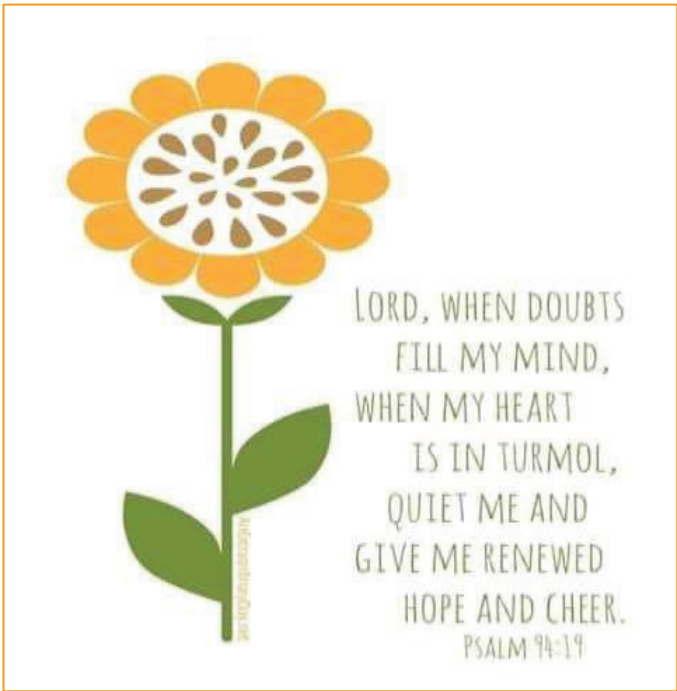

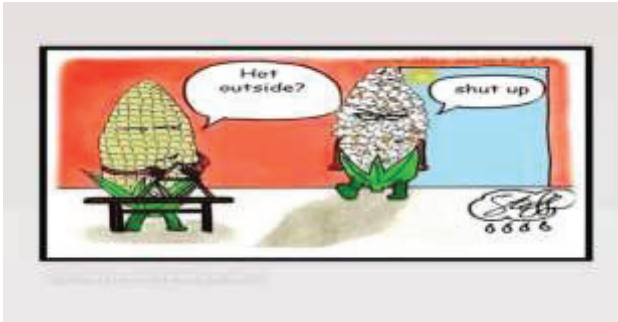
**Second Collection** – The Second Collection this weekend is for Mission Co-op.
