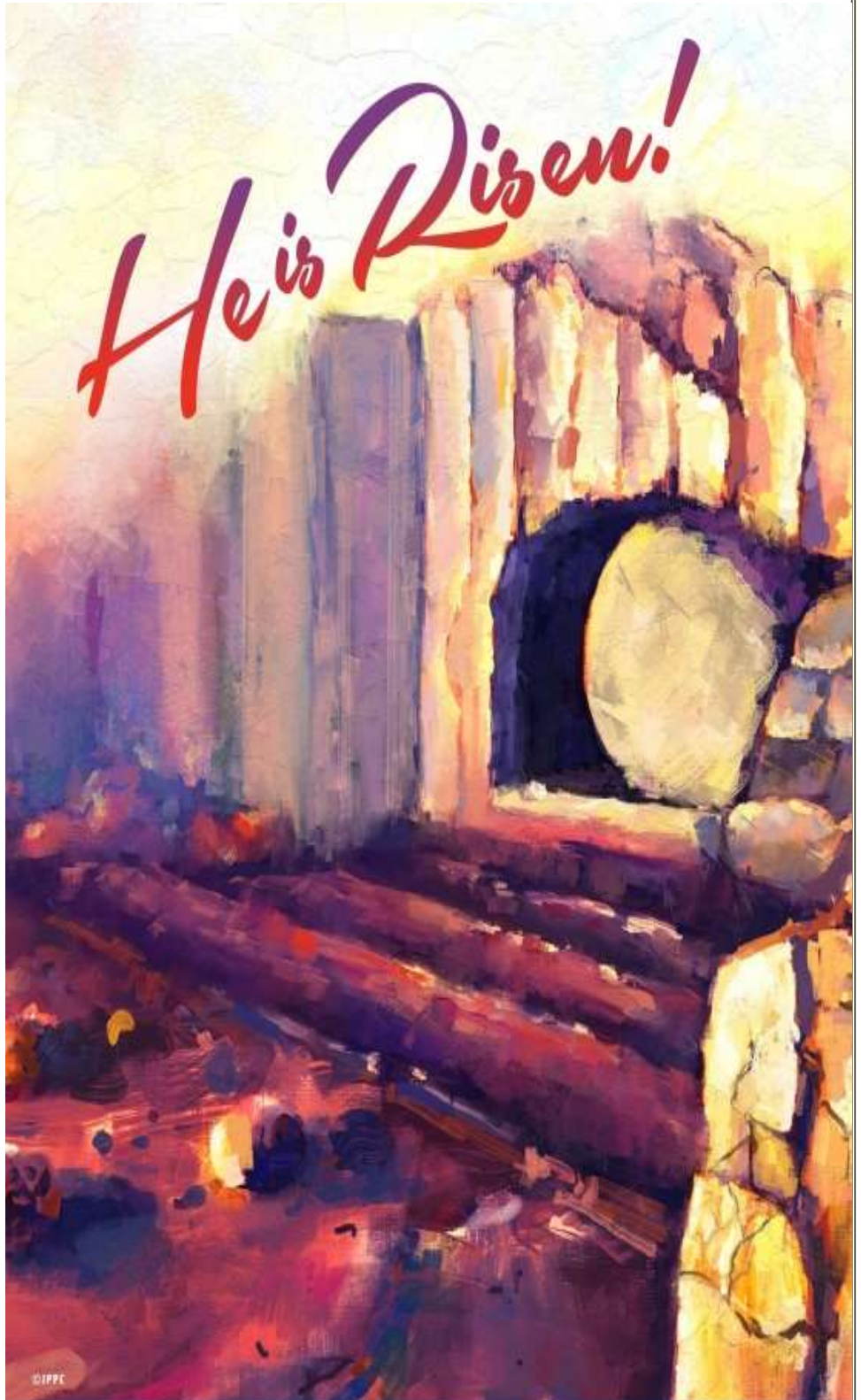

We will be required to obtain 3 estimates and then submit to the Archdiocese for approval. The process is longer than we first anticipated but I will update you with any new developments. Eastertide ends on the 50th day after Easter, which is known as Pentecost Sunday.

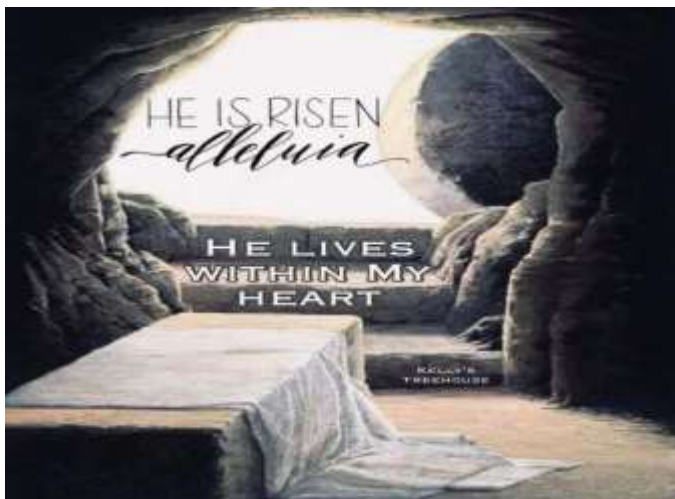
