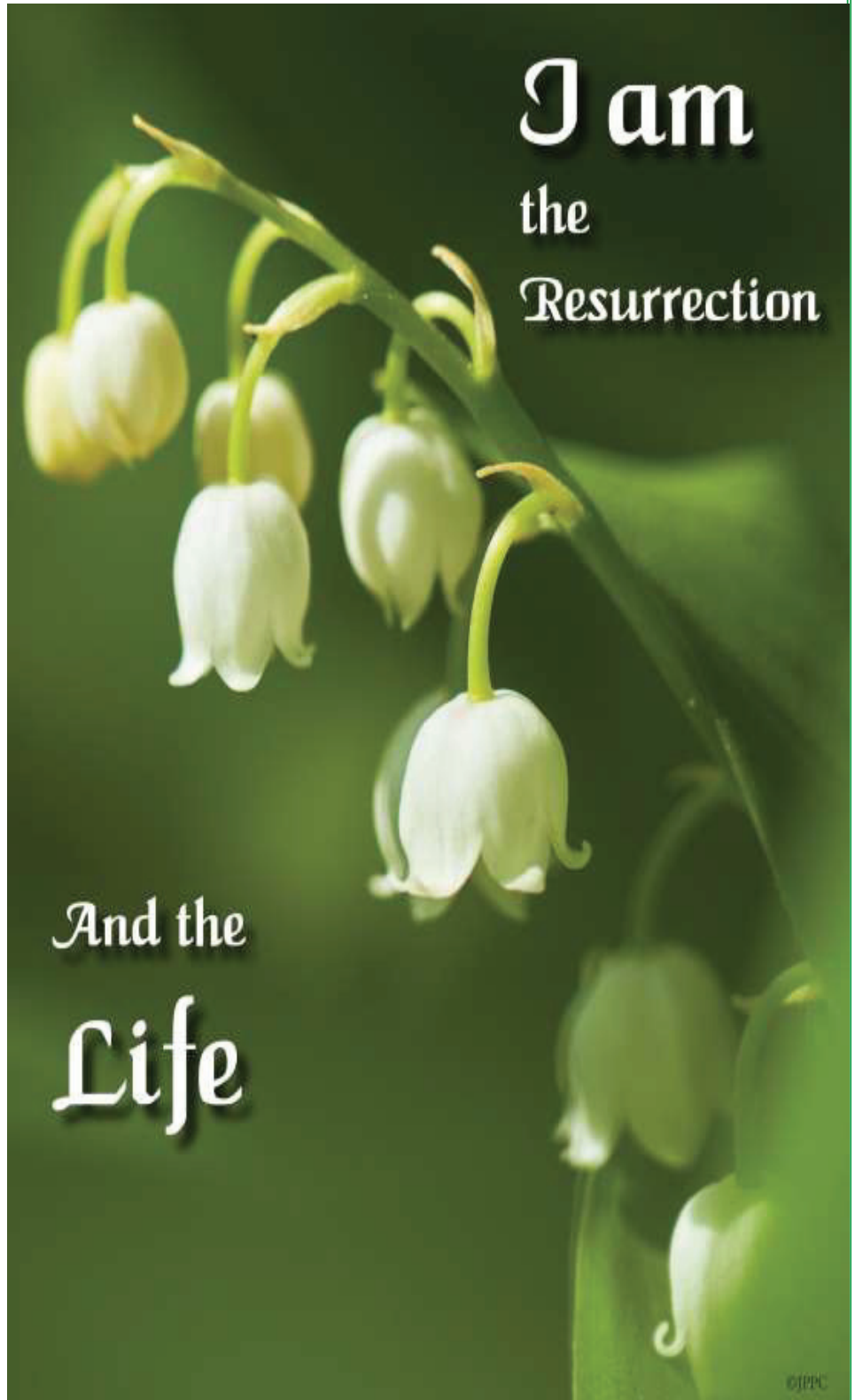

THIS WEEK AT ST. ISAAC'S

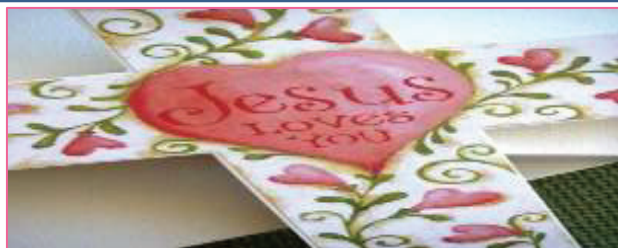

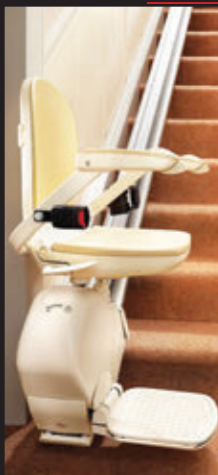

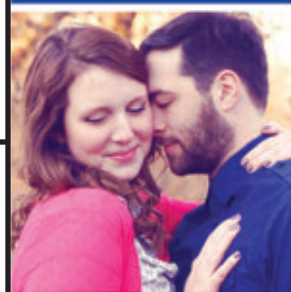
