Sacrament of the Sick: Please call the Office.

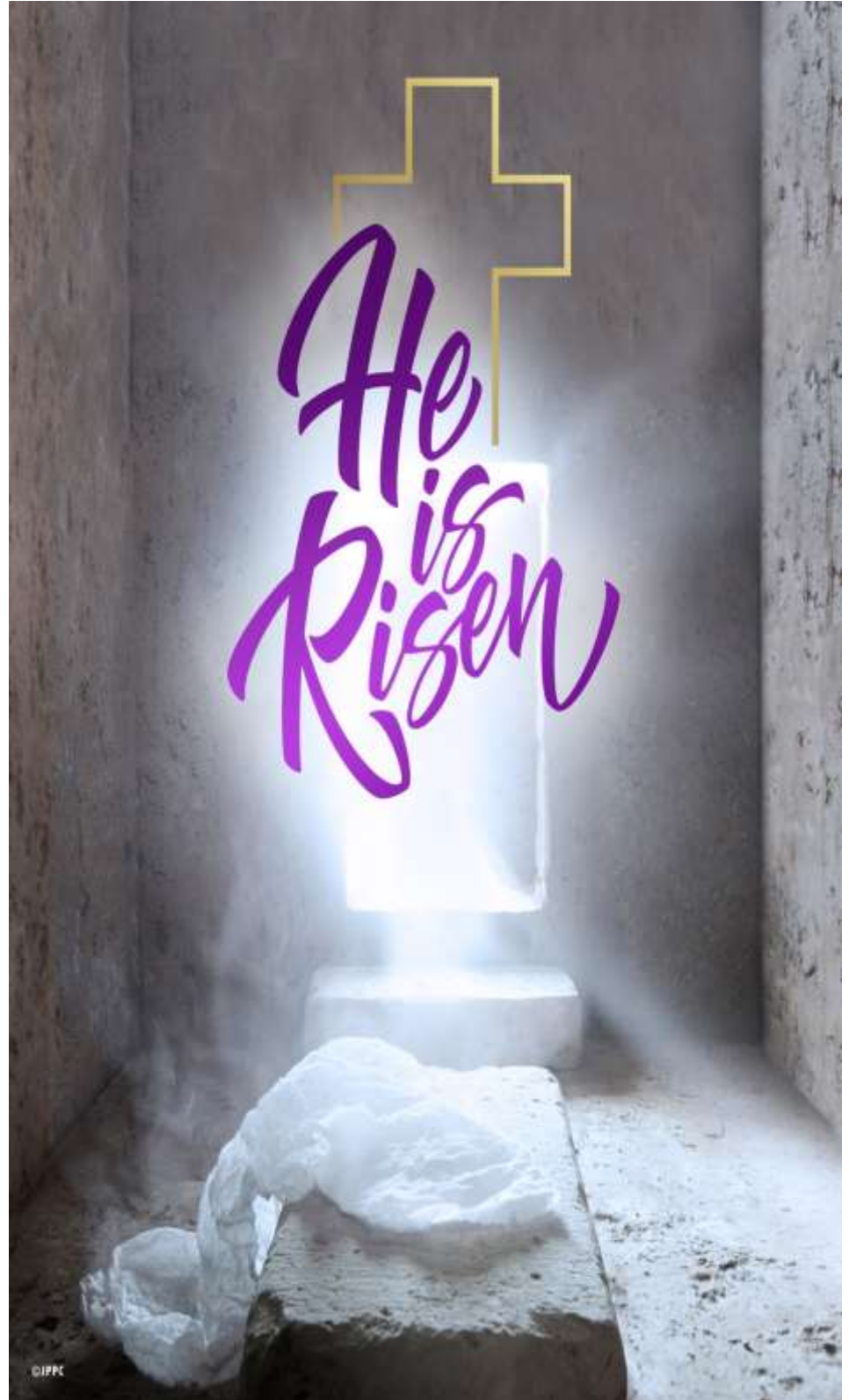

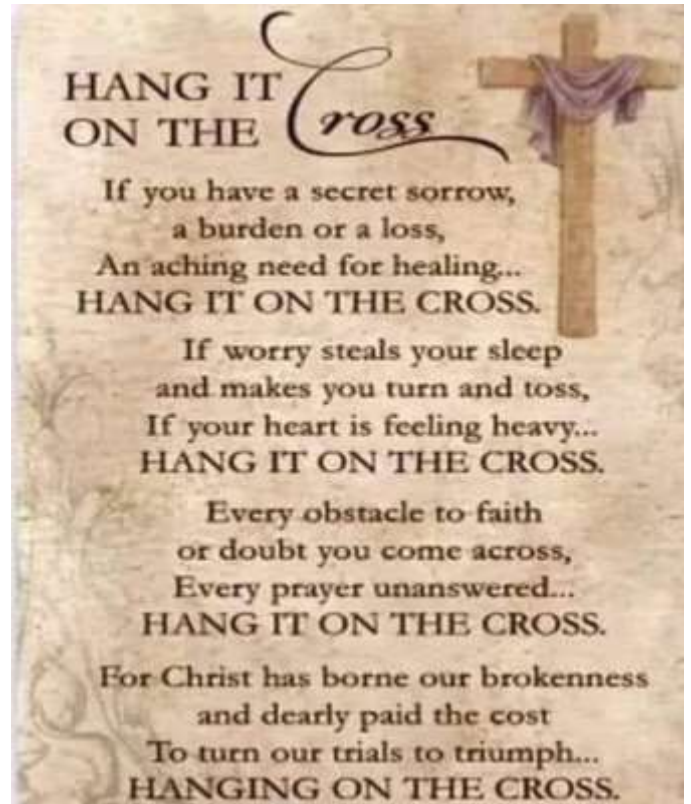


Walking with Purpose Walking with Purpose The Bible study **Rooted and Radiant** will conclude this Wednesday, April
