

We are grateful to Bill for his long employment here at St. Isaac's which began in 1999.


We wish Bill all the best as he enters this new chapter in his life!

WHAT DRAWS PEOPLE INTO THE CATHOLIC FAITH?


While there are many different circumstances that lead a person in the direction of Catholicism, the simple answer is, "Because God has called them."
