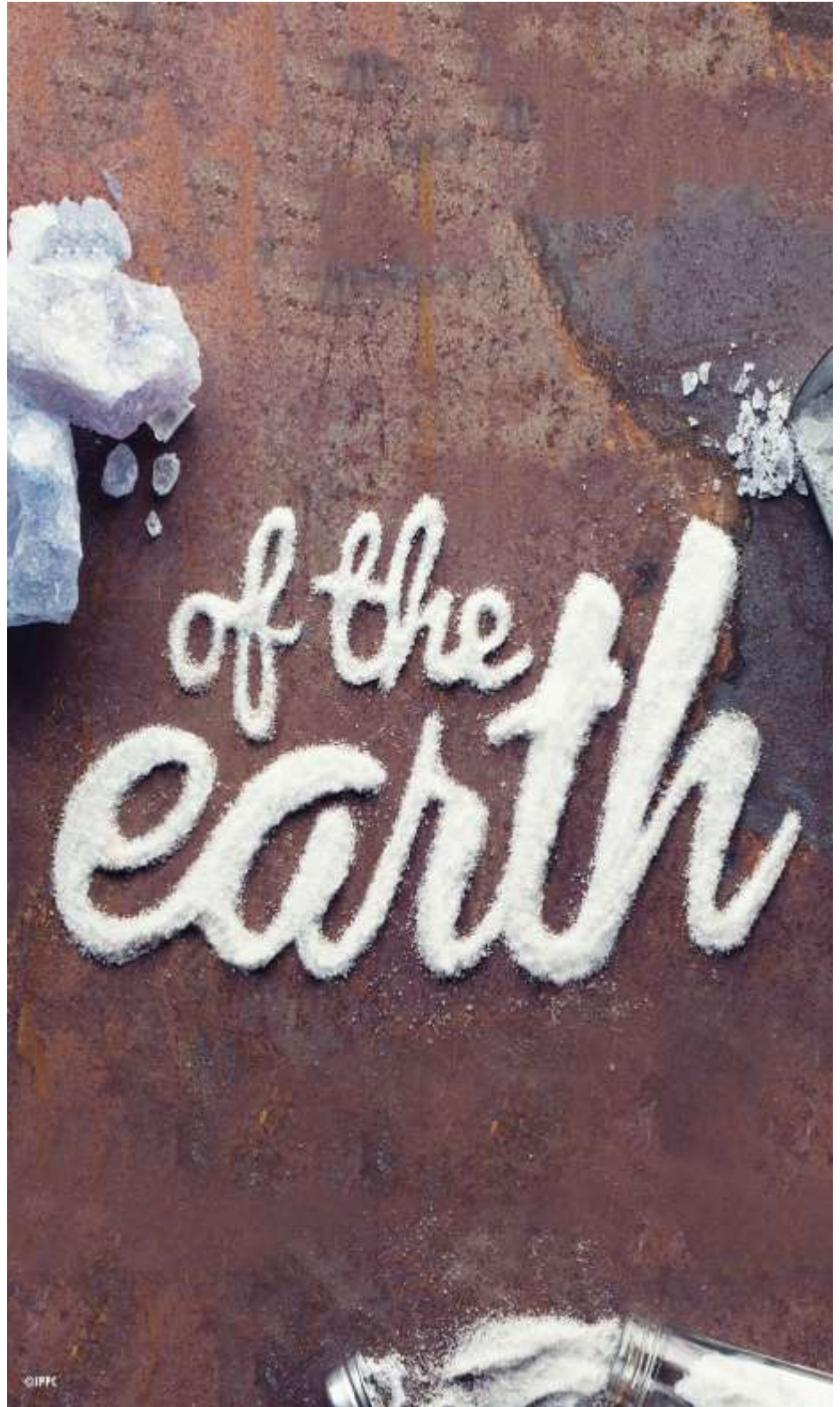

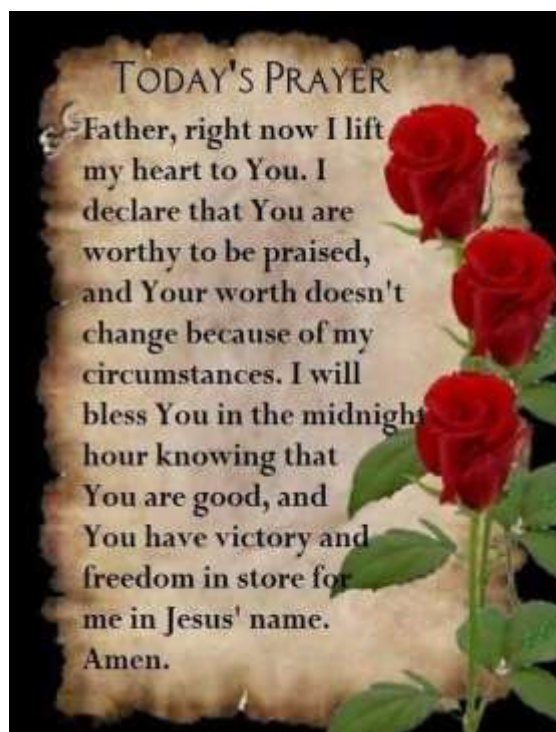

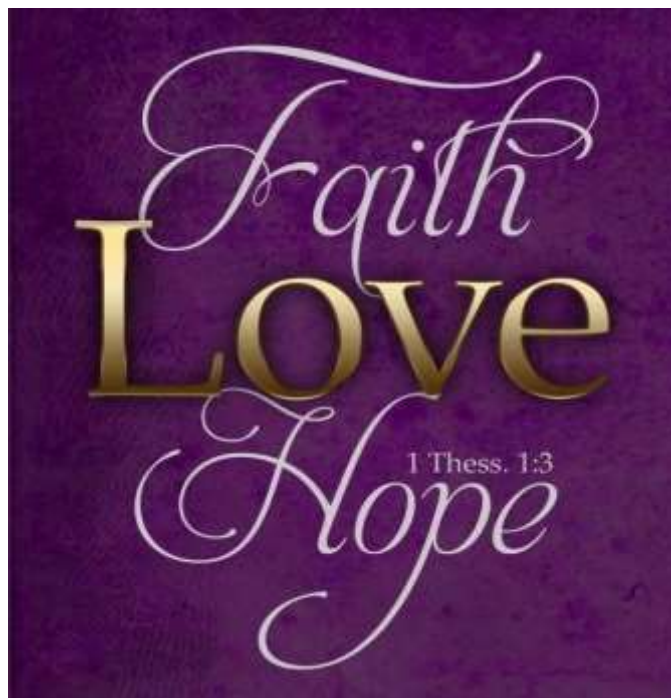
The contractor has begun a 2 week project on the Church sanctuary. Masses will take place in the parish hall going forward. HOW EXCITING!!!
