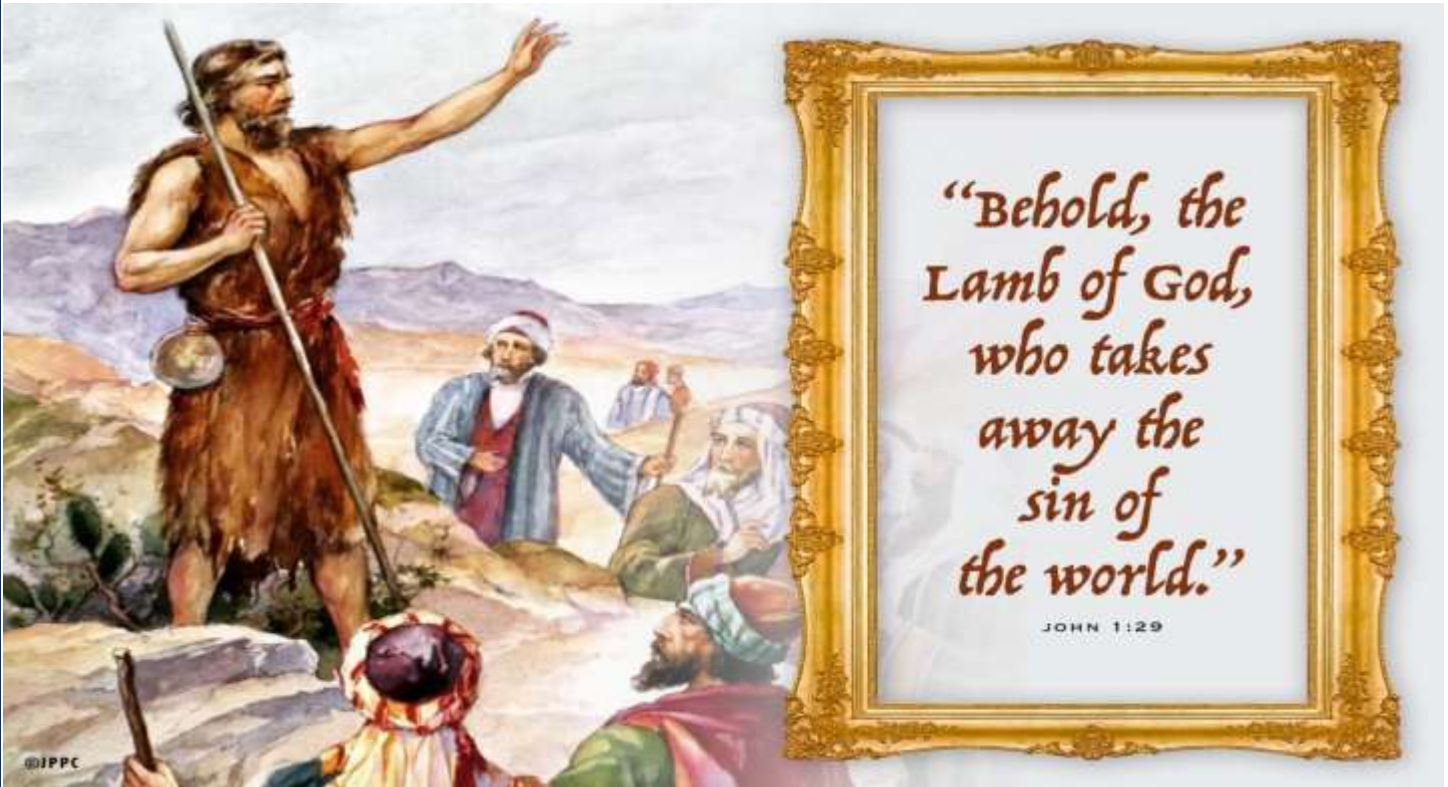

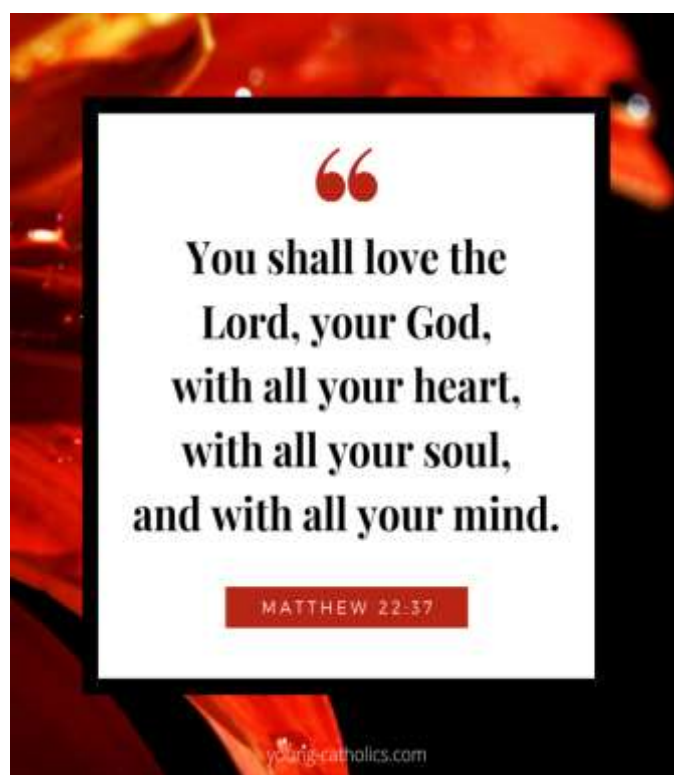

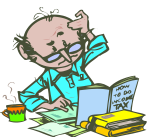
BEQUESTS TO OUR PARISH
