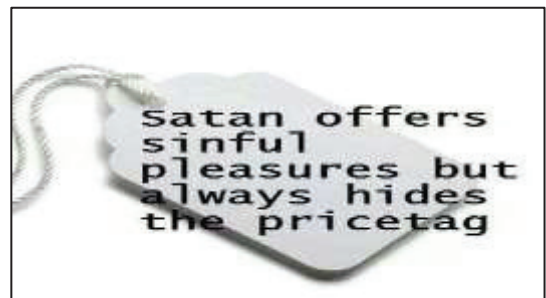
First Reading – Jeremiah 23:1-6 (107B)

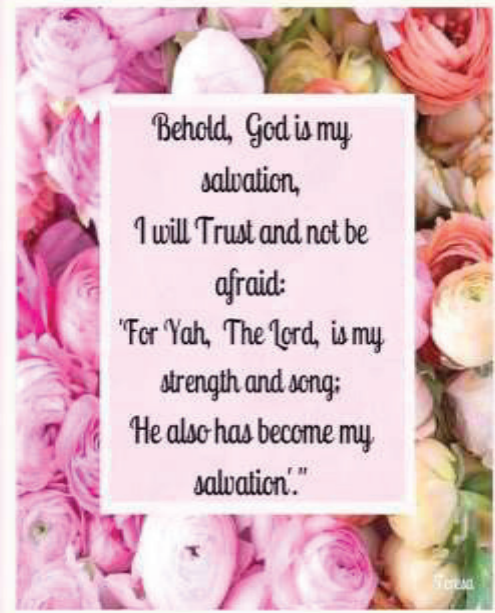

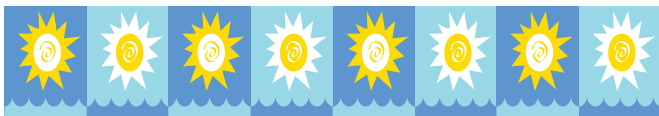
