*Father, remind us to pray when we are tempted to complain.*


*Remind us to have faith.*


CCD in 2021-2022 will return to "in person" class in the Fall. Registration forms can be found on the parish website and should be returned by July 5<sup>th</sup>.

**WHAT DRAWS PEOPLE INTO THE CATHOLIC FAITH?**


While there are many different circumstances that lead a person in the direction of Catholicism, the simple answer is, "Because God has called them."


