Heart Happy Tomato Soup

- 46 oz. can tomato juice
- 8 oz. can tomato sauce
- ½ cup water
- 1 tbsp. vegetable granules
- 1 sprig celery leaves, chopped
- ½ onion, thinly sliced
- ½ tsp. dried basil
- 2 tbsp. Sugar
- 1 bay leaf
- ½ tsp. whole cloves

Combine all ingredients in greased slow cooker. Stir well.

Cover. Cook on low 5-8 hours. Remove bay leaf and cloves before serving.

Second Collection - The Second Collection this weekend will be for the Churches in Latin America.



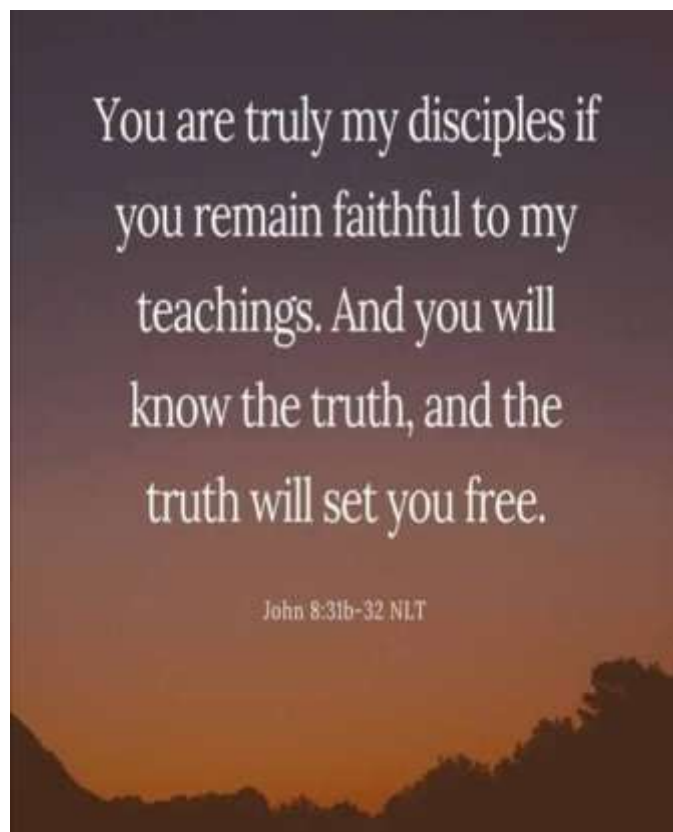
Please join us after the 10:30 am Mass for a coffee social hosted by the Adult Formation Group.

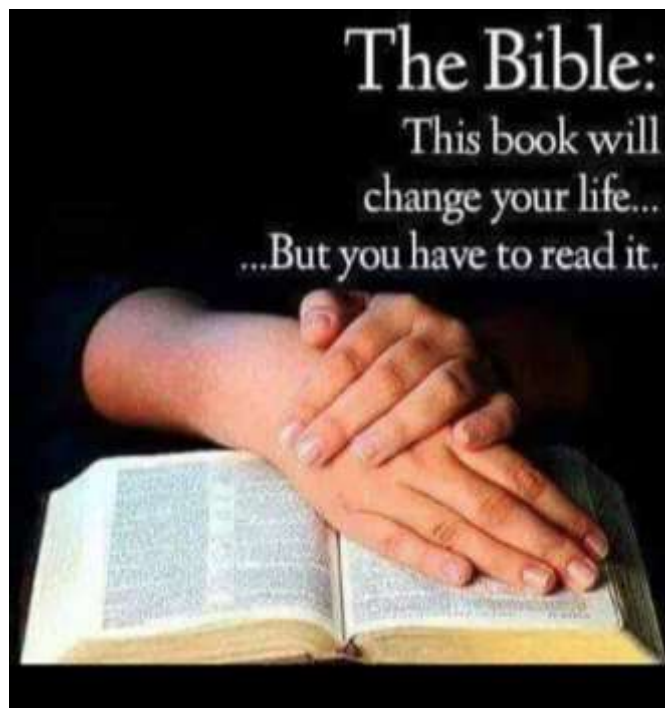
WHAT DRAWS PEOPLE INTO THE CATHOLIC FAITH?
