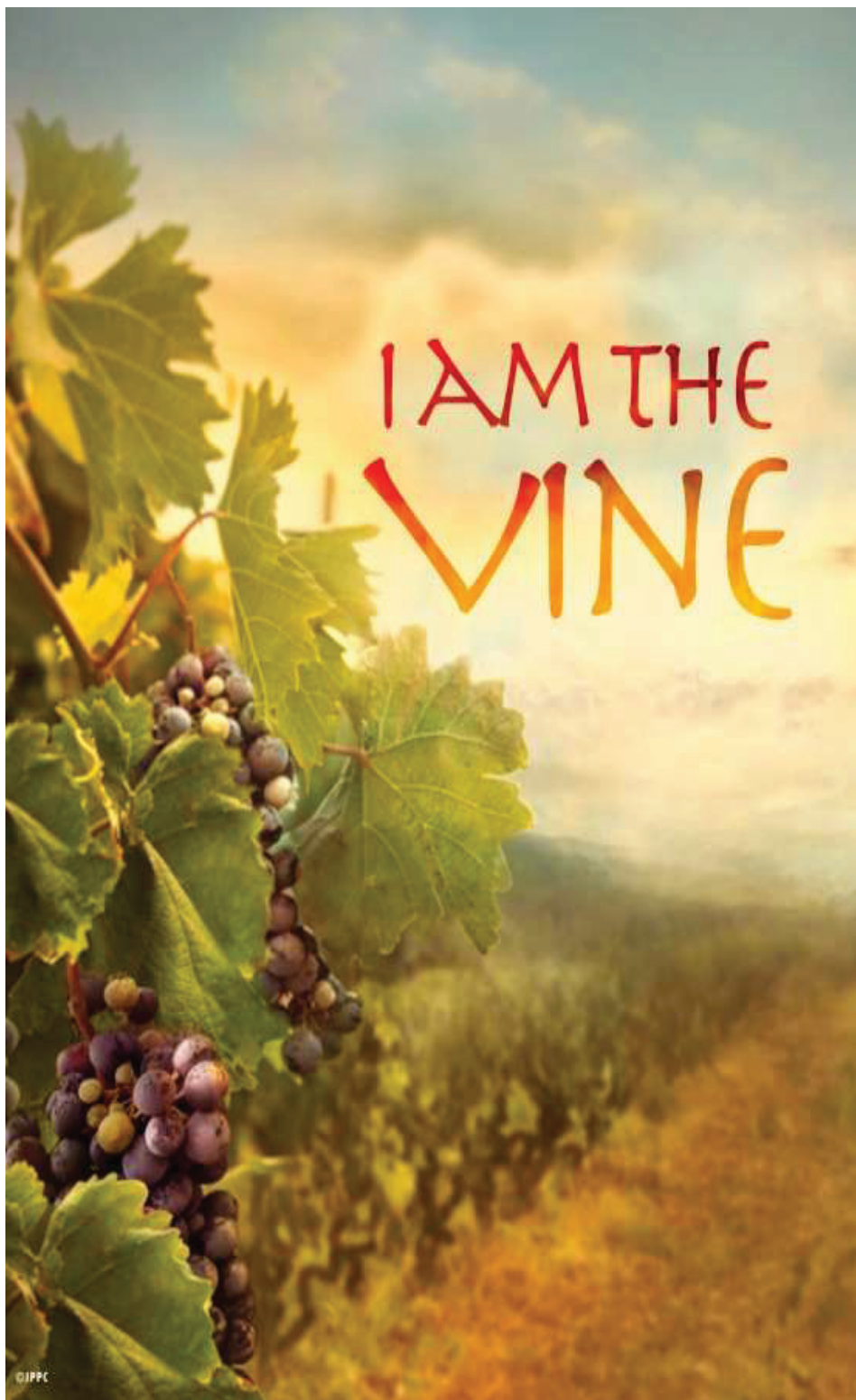

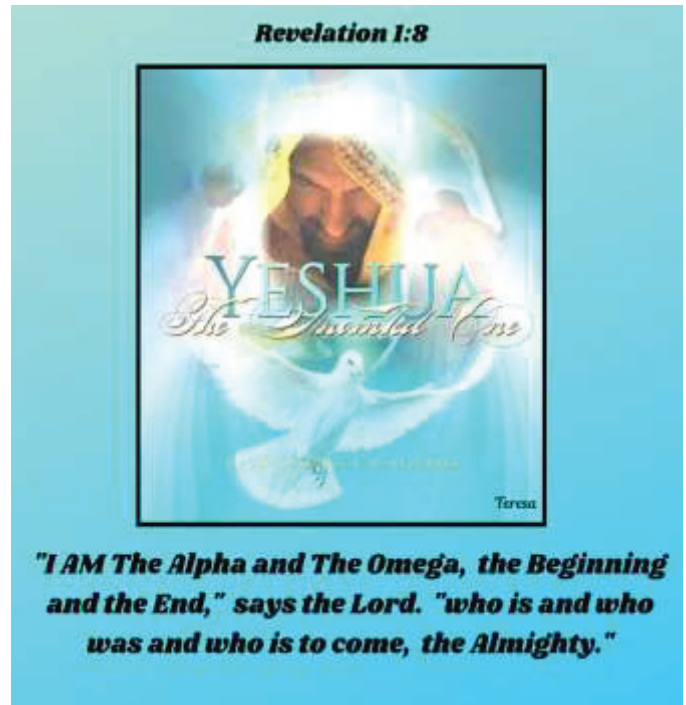

**THE PILGRIM VIRGIN STATUE OF OUR LADY OF FATIMA** -In 1917, **Our Blessed Mother** appeared to three children, Lucia, Jacinta and Francisco in Fatima, Portugal. She appeared on the 13<sup>th</sup> of the month from May 1917 to October 1917.

In 1946, Pope Pius XII sent his Papal Legate to bless the first **Pilgrim Virgin Statue of Our Lady of Fatima**. He said he was crowning her "Queen of the World". Since then thousands of smaller statues have been blessed. They are used for the home visitation program. **Our Lady's visit is a special time of grace.**

WHAT DRAWS PEOPLE INTO THE CATHOLIC FAITH?

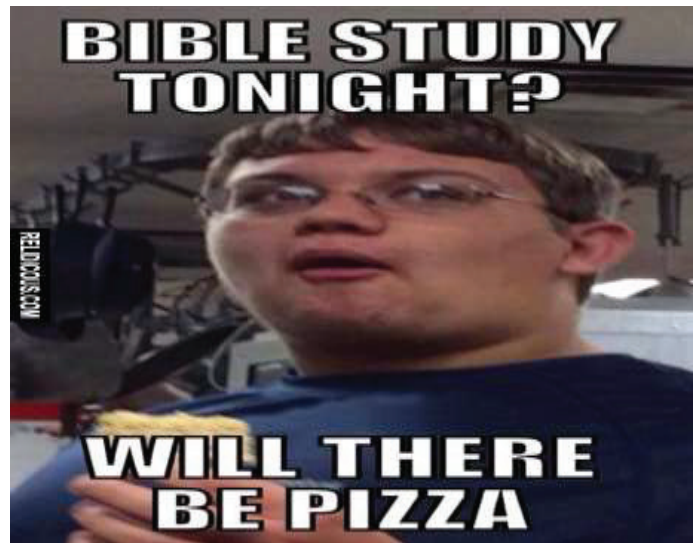
While there are many different circumstances that lead a person in the direction of Catholicism, the simple answer is, "Because God has called them."

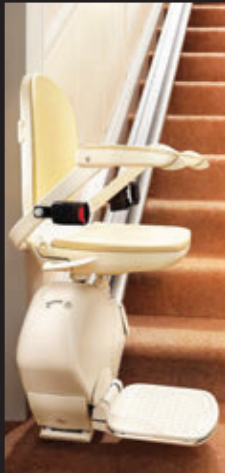

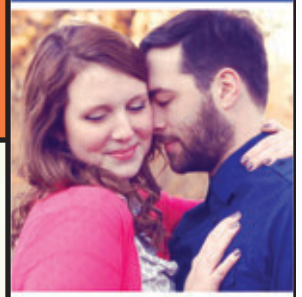

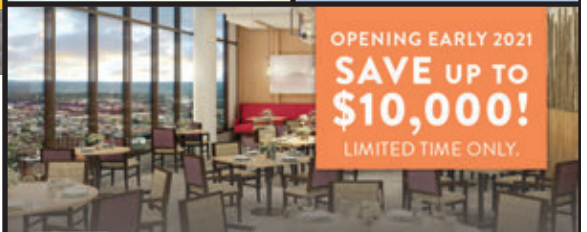
