THE PILGRIM VIRGIN STATUE OF OUR LADY OF FATIMA

In 1917, **Our Blessed Mother** appeared to three children, Lucia, Jacinta and Francisco in Fatima, Portugal. *She appeared on the 13th, of the month from May 1917 to October 1917.*

In 1946, Pope Pius XII sent his Papal Legate to bless the first **Pilgrim Virgin Statue of Our Lady of Fatima**. He said he was crowning her “Queen of the World”. Since then thousands of smaller statues have been blessed. They are used for the home visitation program. ***Our Lady’s visit is a special time of grace.***

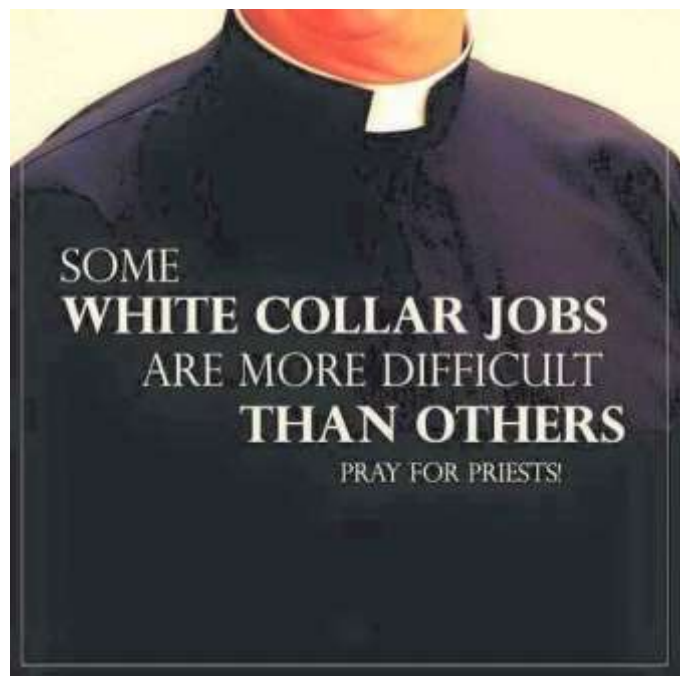
