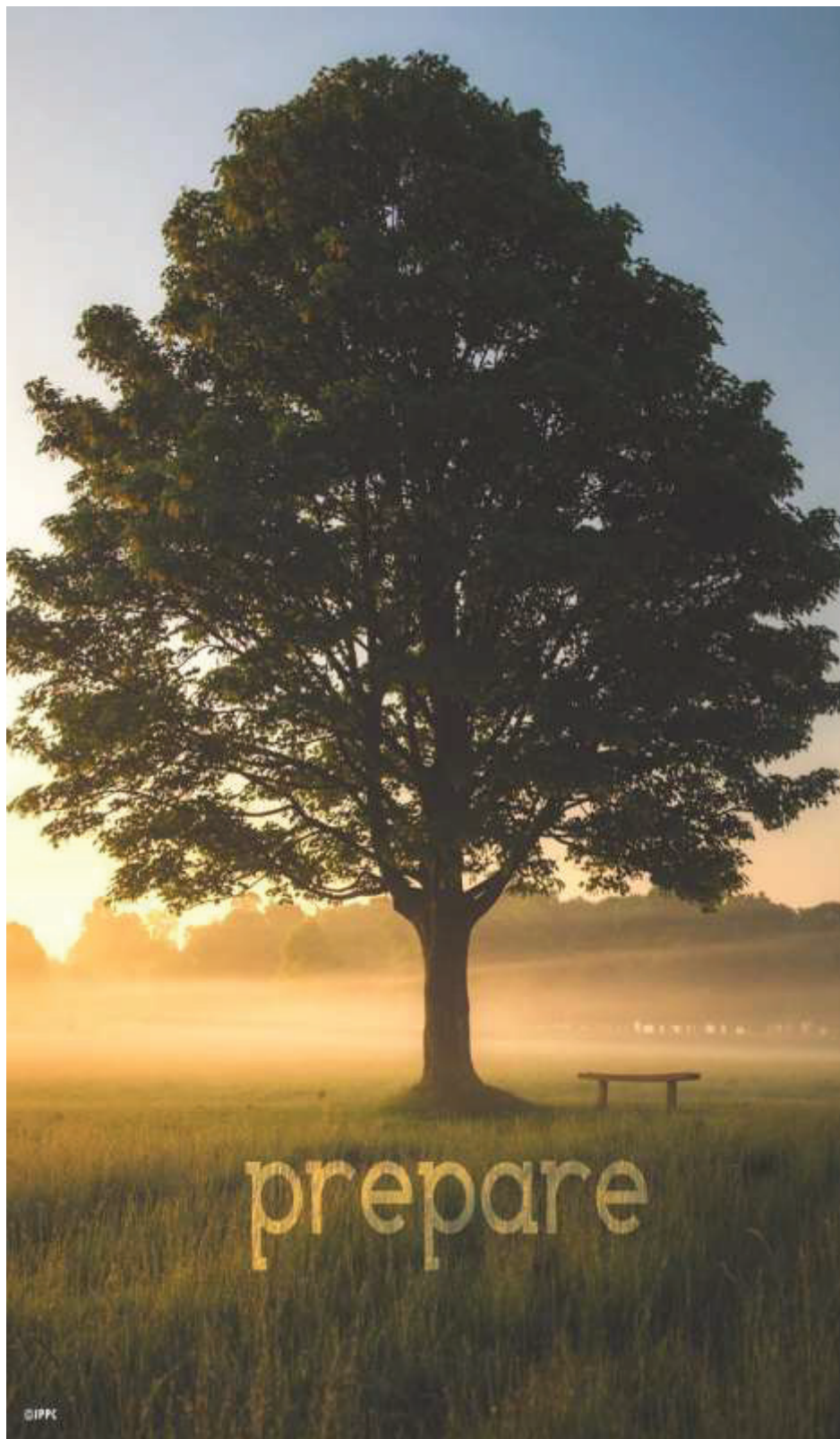

**Replacement of Carpeting in the Church**

This temporary fix has run its course and we believe it is necessary to replace the carpeting sooner rather than later.

Additional funds are needed after several recent expensive projects, i.e., Air conditioning systems being replaced in the church, chapel and library among other projects regarding property upkeep have significantly reduced our Capital Improvement account.

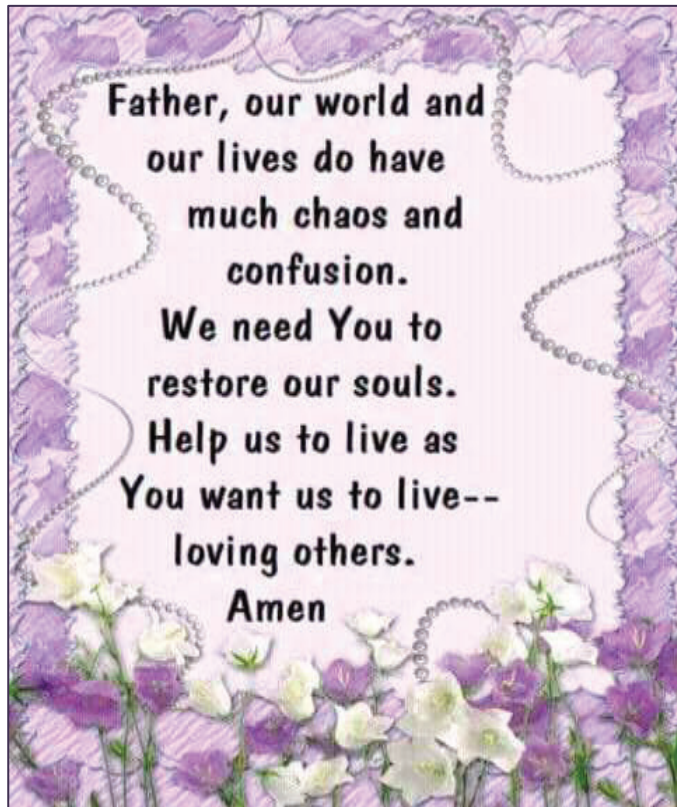
