

## THEME

Human behavior runs according to very strong habits. Our tools have purposes. It would be very strange for us to see someone modifying a tool for a new purpose. Isaiah, however, promises that such things will happen, with the changing of the hearts.



**The Advent Wreath** has its origins in Germany in the sixteenth century. The wreath - a circle of evergreens symbolizing God's eternal love - holds four candles, three violet, and one pink. Violet is the traditional penitential color of Advent, and the pink candle symbolizing joy is lit on Gaudete (Joyful) Sunday, the Third Sunday of the season. As we light the four candles one by one, we're reminded of how God's light has gradually illuminated the world's darkness through history, culminating in Jesus, the light of the World and the Sun of Justice.






