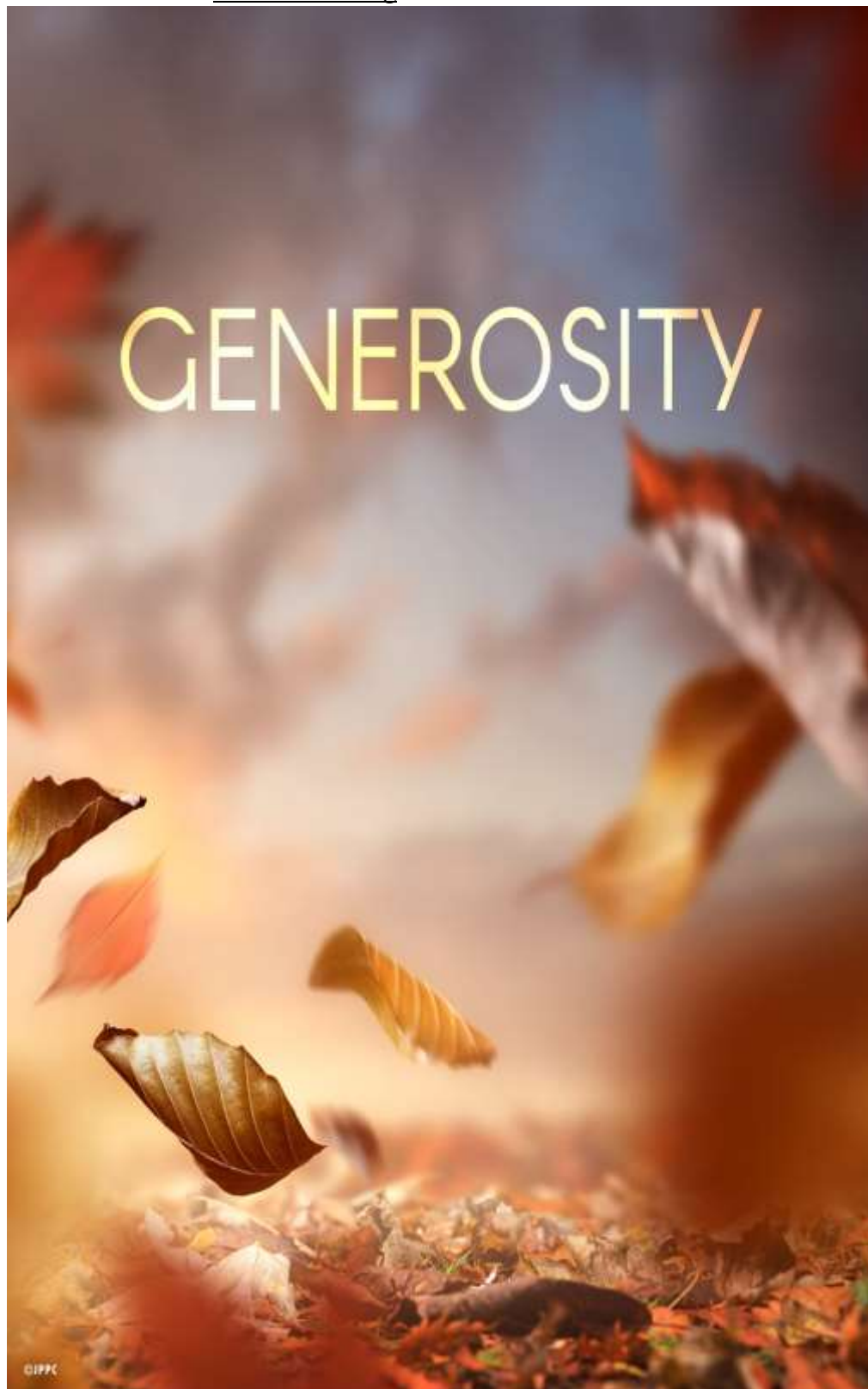

**Replacement of Carpeting in the Church**

During our past summers, the humidity in the air has caused our carpeting to buckle and the glue that holds it down to lose its effectiveness.

We have, each fall, brought in carpet professionals to secure and glue the carpet back down so that it would lay flat.

This temporary fix has run its course and we believe it is necessary to replace the carpeting sooner rather than later.

We are using the donations collected at the 2nd collection on Nov.13-14th in the Capital Improvement envelopes for this project. Additional funds are needed after several recent expensive projects, i.e., Air conditioning systems being replaced in the church, chapel and library among other projects regarding property upkeep have significantly reduced our Capital Improvement account.
