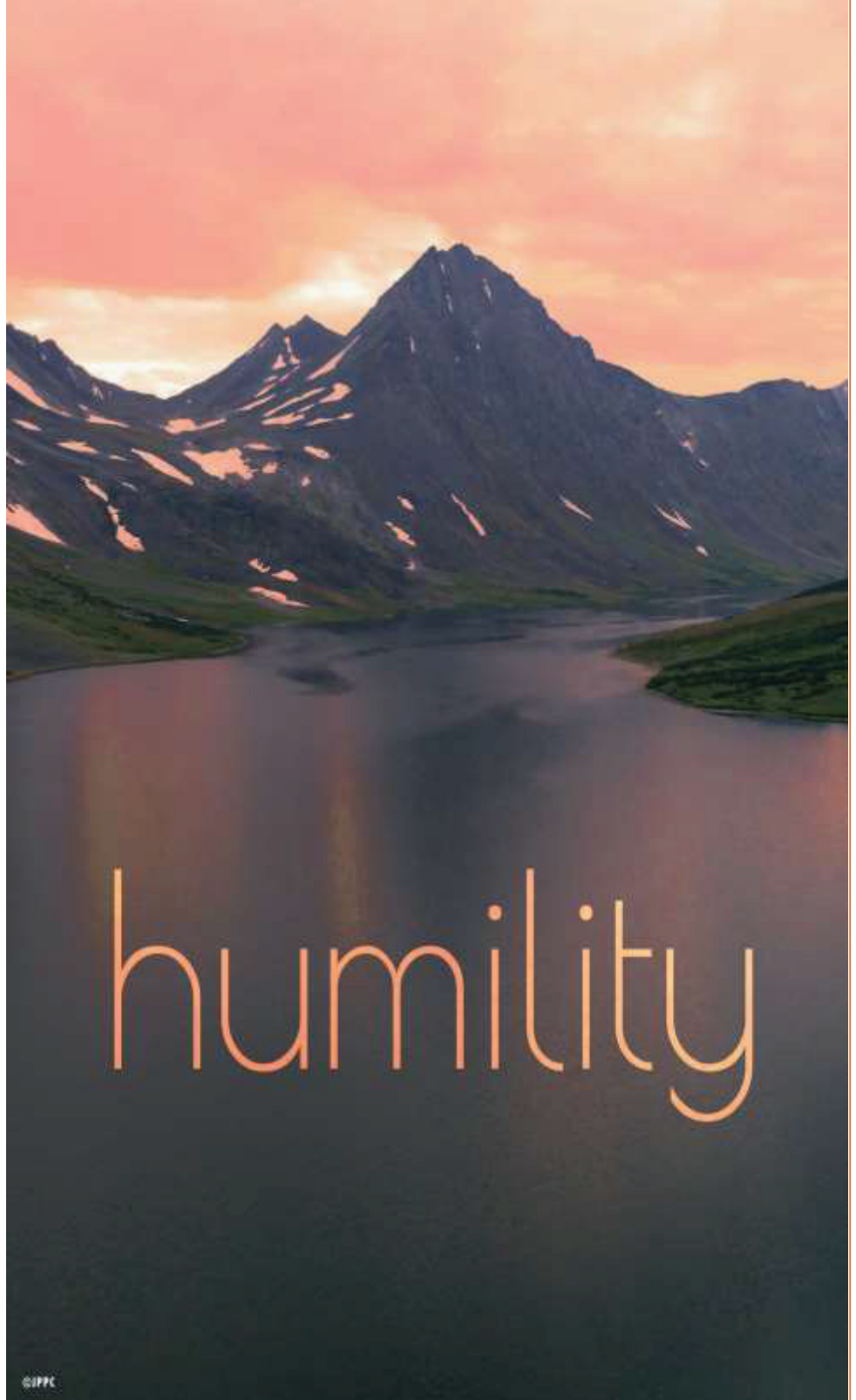

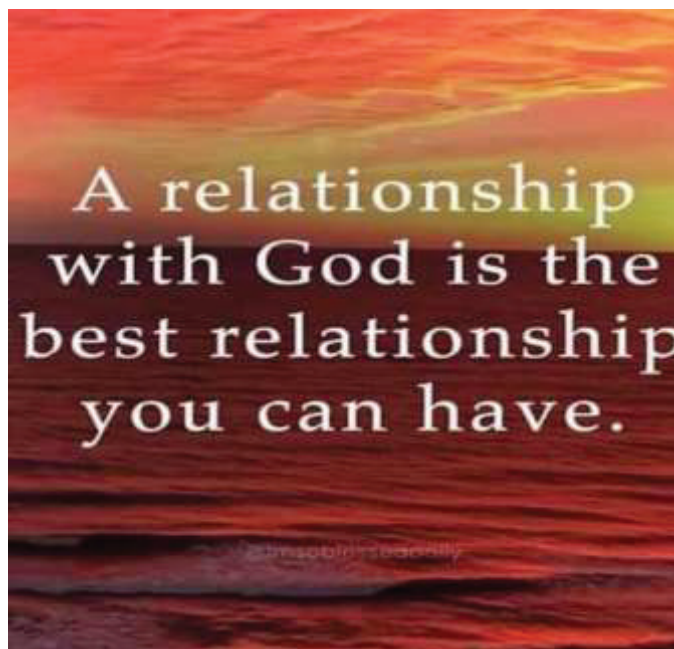
The Youth Group will be selling pumpkins after Masses this weekend. If you purchase on any other days please bring the monies to the Rectory Office. Thank you for your support.

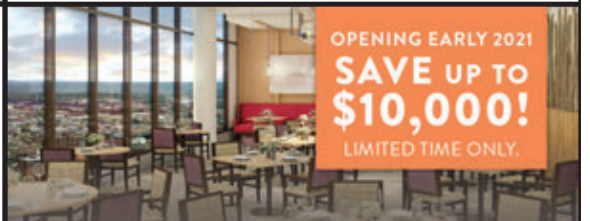
