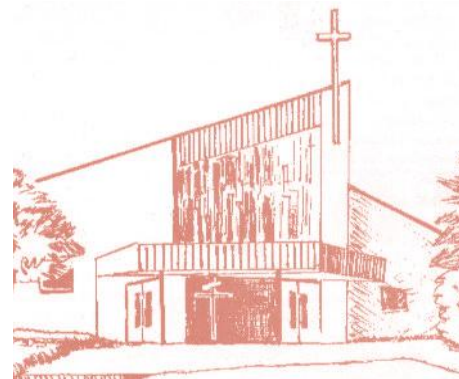

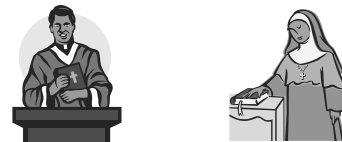
CATHOLIC STEWARDSHIP



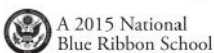
